



American Rescue Plan ESSER III Use of Funds Plan

Adams 14 has analyzed multiple forms of data: Acadiance K-2 (ELA), STAR 3-5 (ELA and Math), Interim Assessments, parent and community surveys and attendance. Based on the data results, Adams 14 School District has determined that students have experienced a decline in all content areas. Data shows that there was a decline in academic performance for English Language Learners and students with disabilities compared to the general population.

In selecting our evidence based interventions District staff have identified the following areas of impact: Academics, Social Emotional/Behavior, and Engagement. These impact areas are outlined in our recovery assurances, school allocation plan guidelines, and guidance documents. Our budget allocations include line items for Reading Interventionists, Student Engagement Advocates, Graduation coaches and community engagement for Central Elementary School as well as Non-discretionary allocations (Hazard pay, additional substitutes, technology supports, Parent Liaisons to full time and PPE materials).

Each school will receive an allocation of funds to support our areas of impact. School recovery plans must include: Before or After school programming for Elementary School, Positive Behavior Intervention services or PBIS resources and support for recovering student learning loss. The School Recovery plans and support staff allocations will be monitored throughout the school year to ensure there is student progress and recovery of learning loss. Adams 14 School District Executive Leadership in conjunction will progress monitor student data through the PLC process (Acadiance/STAR 3X a year, End of Units and weekly standards aligned assessments). The recovery plans will be monitored to ensure that the interventions around academics, social emotional/behavior and Engagement are addressing the identified students' needs.

A categorical breakdown of our funding allocates approximately 25% for school allocations; 15% for summer school and BluePrint Math tutoring; 40% for additional staffing; and 20% for other items including substitutes, contract services for online instruction; contact tracing, additional PPE, and indirect cost. Updates will be made to this Use of Funds Plan document as changes are determined.
